



Gennum Corporation completed conversion of the majority of our products to fully RoHS compliant formats well in advance of the EU RoHS Directive deadline. We are currently shipping more than 98% of our product in RoHS compliant formats. We have however committed to maintain production on a limited set of Pb-based packages to meet specific customer requirements. These customers require products that are currently exempt under the Pb in solder exemption for infrastructure applications. Note that ALL Pb-based products are RoHS '5 of 6' compliant. Gennum segregates Pb-based products from Pb-free products and uses unique product marking and naming to identify these products. Gennum Corporation is prepared to convert these products to Pb-free formats based on customer schedules, in advance of the expiration of the Pb in solder exemption.

Some of Gennum's Optical Module and ROSA products contain optical glass lenses which contain Pb. These products are completely RoHS compliant based on the RoHS exemption for Pb in Glass. There are no plans to convert these products to other materials as the glass lens is a fundamental component in the optical path for these products.

Gennum products do not contain Deca-BDE above the threshold of 1000ppm for PBDE as identified in EU Directive 2002/95/EC and are in compliance with the directive.

Gennum products do not contain as intentional additives perfluorooctane sulfonates (PFOS) as identified in EU Directive 2006/122/EC (30th amendment to EU Directive 76/769/EEC). Gennum has identified that some processes at our foundries use PFOS in small quantities, however this material is entirely removed prior to shipment to Gennum and is not contained in any of our parts as delivered to our customers. Currently, there are no suitable replacements for its use in the manufacture of these products. Gennum continues to monitor this situation with our suppliers.
